[DESCRIPTION]

The Connected Switchgear I-TOUCH® Series is a collection of touch controlled glass switch panels designed for residential and commercial use. The range includes socket outlets, wall switches and smart dimmers in a variety of configurations. Each product includes an extensive feature set including the option of controlling a remote relay of 30amp and the remote control button in another panel via a wired interface.

Smart dimmers can be used to control a wide variety of loads including capacitive and inductive loads by using auto load detection circuitry.

Whilst the products can be used standalone, in order to benefit from the full feature set, wireless group control functionality has been incorporated into its design that allows button groups of up to 16 buttons to be controlled using a single button in up to 33 panels. When installing the products in conjunction with the I-TOUCH® Series gateway interface, up to 128 panels can be controlled by any smart device and anywhere around the world with an Internet connection.

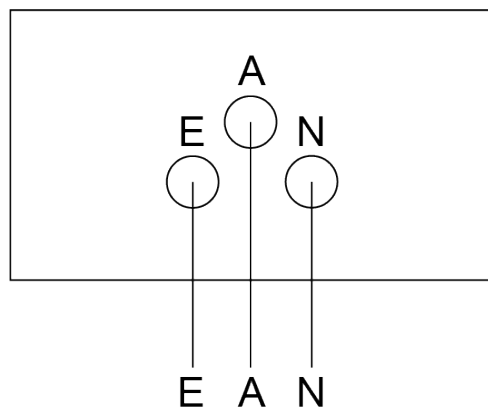

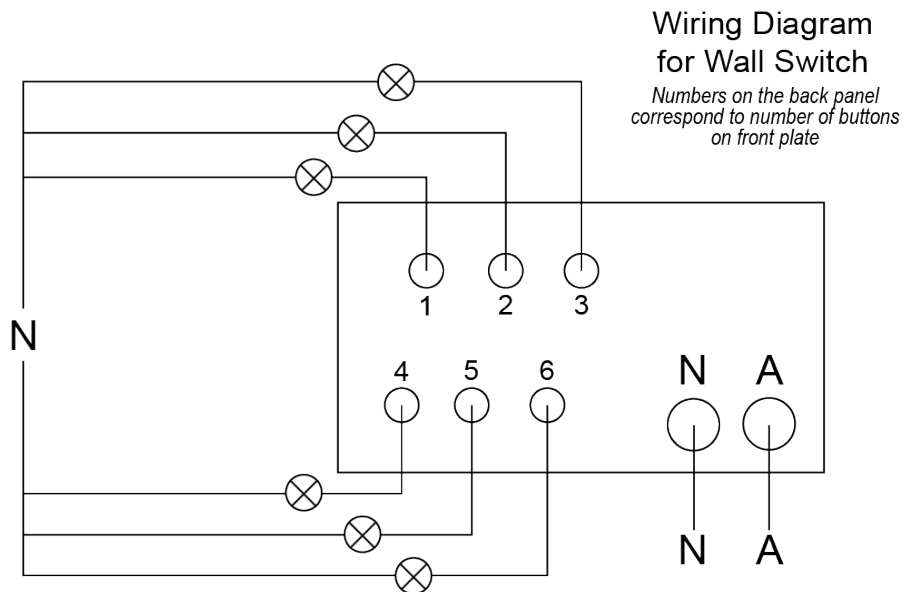

T-R30 Wiring Diagram

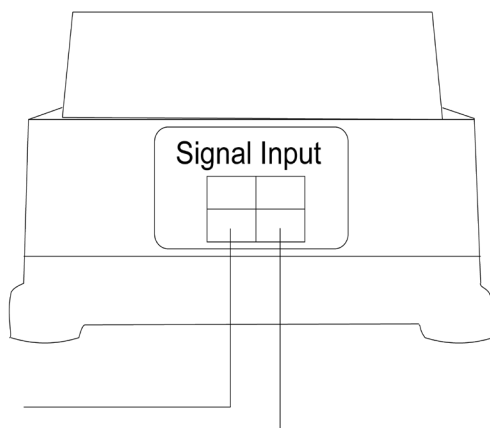
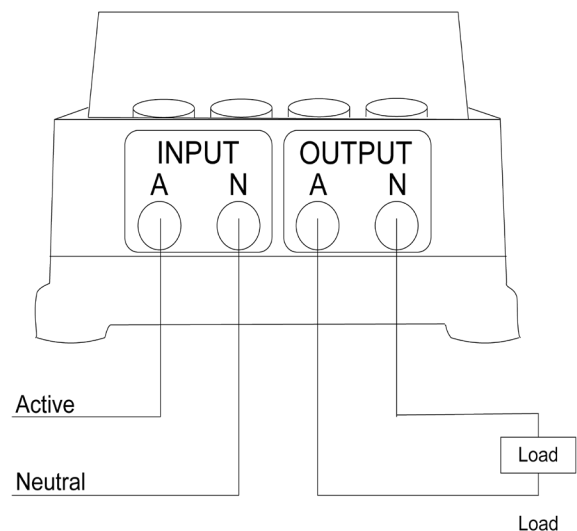


fig 8 cable to ports A/B on

[INSTALLATION NOTES]

WARNING - PLEASE READ THIS DOCUMENT PRIOR TO INSTALLING

iTOUCH® Home Automation devices are electronic products and as such require more than usual installation care. To ensure warranty is not voided, please take care during installation of the following:

1. When connecting loads (wiring accessories or luminaires) to any panel except dimmer panels, it is imperative that the total load requirement of the connected devices does not exceed the rating of the panel. Failure to follow this directive may result in product failure and void warranty.

If capacitive or inductive loads are connected, and in the event that the power requirement of the load is not indicated on the product packaging, you should contact the manufacturer for specific information that relates to the total power requirement of the device and ensure this value rating does not exceed the rating of the panel.

Please note that many LED globes with an advertised rating of 7-10W can have as high as 100amps of inrush current, which is not advertised on the product packaging

In instances where the total power requirement exceeds the panel rating, you may have options that safely connect the device to the iTOUCH® panel such as installing a current limiting device or larger relay switching device between the iTOUCH® panel and the load connected.

2. BEFORE connecting power to the iTOUCH® products, it is imperative that you have installed surge arrestors in the electrical system before the wired circuits of iTOUCH® products to ensure the products are not affected by voltage surges. Each incoming and phase and neutral will require a surge arrestor device.
3. NEVER connect an iTOUCH® panel to live power. Ensure all wiring connections are terminated PRIOR to making electrical circuits live.
4. Ensure that the products as installed are not being exposed to building dust or debris from the buildings wall construction.

[INSTALLATION NOTES CONT.]

5. Do not overtighten the panels to the wall surface. This can lead to plate distortion if the wall surface is not flat and can result in poor contact between the glass plate cover and the silicone button pads. This will result in loss of button sensitivity.
6. Ensure that the panels are not installed further than 9 metres apart.
7. After installation of the glass plates, the panel will calibrate its touch sensitivity. During this initial calibration, it is possible for the buttons to enter locked mode. If so, when the button is touched it will flash white 3 times.

To unlock, touch and hold a button for 10 seconds. After 5 seconds the button will flash blue 3 times. Continue to hold until the button flashes green 3 times, indicating the button is now enabled.

To lock a button, simply reverse the above procedure. After 10 seconds the button will flash blue 3 times.
